2nd August, 2023

Aptitude Training & Sectoral Presentations

5th August, 2023


Session 1: - Talent Hunt

- 5. Embrace continuous learning and skill development.
- 6. Prioritize grooming and etiquette.
- 7. Practice hypothetical questions.
- 8. Maintain relevance.

This was followed by Mock Interviews, featuring 6 Panel Members from diverse domains and 5 candidates for HR, Marketing, Finance, Operations, and International Trade roles.

We also learned from an Excel expert, gaining hands-on experience in using formulas, shortcuts, and unique features of Excel.

Event: Promoting Good Citizenship and Respectful Communities


